Here is one of the hottest new things in the quilting world, turn 2 1/2 strips into beautiful area rugs! Learn how to prepare the strips with batting, then sew all your strips together using the zig zag stitch on your sewing machine. A simple binding on the two ends gives it a wonderful finished edge. You can use a jelly roll for this project, or cut forty 2 1/2 strips from your stash to create this beautiful 32 x 42 inch rug. What a great way to use the fabric or jelly rolls that are in your stash. Make a rug for yourself or make several to use as holiday gifts. Christmas is just around the corner!
