You will be surprised how easy this 32 x 42 inch rug is to construct using pre-cut batting and a jelly roll or strips cut from your stash. Simply sew batting into each strip, then zig zag all the strips together. Finish by sewing a binding on the two ends. Come join the class and learn all the tricks and techniques that make this rug a great addition to any room.

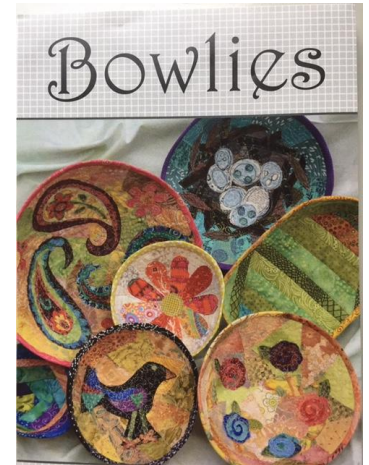

The first class will focus on EPP and the second class putting it all together. If you are looking for a new, portable, hand project, EPP is for you!

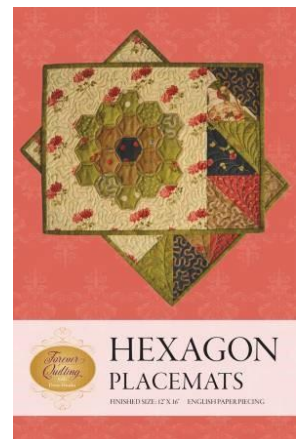

How can you participate?

Here is what you need to make a dress:

Sewing Machine (or ask us if you would like to use one of ours)

Scissors or rotary cutter

1 yd of fabric 100% cotton or cotton/poly 42-45" wide, washed, pressed and squared off (cut straight) and fat quarter. Avoid white, see thru, patriotic, holiday, Disney or fabrics with writing.

Elastic 1/2" wide, a package of EXTRA WIDE DOUBLE FOLD BIAS TAPE, thread, embellishments such as buttons, grosgrain ribbon, rick rack.
